4-H is the youth development program of North Carolina Cooperative Extension. Mitchell County 4-H offers Summer Adventures to provide educational day programs designed to build life skills through shared experiences and hands-on learning. **Youth must be 5 to 18 years of age as of January 1, 2021.** Follow the 3 easy steps to register:

4-H Summer Adventures Registration

The following are required, *without exception*, for 4-H Summer Adventures Registration

- 1. Before Camp Registration:** Enroll as 4-H member at v2.4honline.com (includes health form, emergency contact, program liability waiver, and photo release). Contact Vonda Vaughn if you need help enrolling.
- 2. Register for camps beginning Tuesday, June 8th from 5:00-6:30pm**, in-person at the Mitchell County Cooperative Extension Center. Registration will be first-come, first-served and will continue during normal office hours from 8:00-5:00 on weekdays from June 9 - June 16 or until camps are full.
- 3. Please bring cash or check payable to Mitchell County General Fund.** Payment for camp fees is due in full at time of registration to cover insurance and supplies. Waitlists do not require payment up front, but will be due if a space opens and you accept.

You say you love to get outside and grill? Then this outdoor cooking competition is for you! Youth select a category in which to participate (beef, chicken, pork, turkey or seafood) and develop their own marinades, dry rubs, etc., and prepare their dish for trained, certified chefs! Asheville-Buncombe Technical Community College’s Culinary Arts Program is hosting this event and providing the chef judges! What a great way to hone your culinary skills and get feedback from the pros!



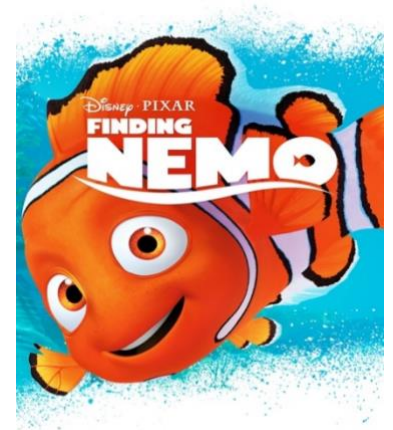


Drive-In Movie *Finding Nemo*

4-H Target Shooting Sports Workshop

July 6-8 (Tues-Thurs) | 9am-3pm | Ages 8-18 | \$40

Special instructions: Participant's parent or guardian must attend.

Are you interested in learning how to properly shoot a bow and arrow and a .22 rifle, 20 or 12- gauge shotgun? Then this workshop is for you! This is a beginner class designed to give youth with little or no target shooting experience an opportunity to learn! Our 4-H Target Shooting Sports Certified Instructors will provide instruction. 4-H Drone Project

July 12-23 | Ages 13-18 | Independent Project with Group Activities

In partnership with Inner Banks STEM Center and For the Win Robotics, this is an independent project where participants will receive a drone kit and online course credentials to Nearpod. The drone is a mini-drone and safe for indoor flight (wowers!). Participants will work through the program self-paced, at home and will have regular access (between the hours of 8am – 5pm) to a flight instructor, via phone in case there are questions or problems. Periodically, participants will have check-ins with our trained 4-H volunteers! Spaces are very limited so don't wait! Sign up early!

- NO phone, email, fax, or mail-in registration will be accepted.
- All registration fees are *non-refundable*, unless a class is cancelled.
- Camp spaces will *not* be held without member enrollment at v2.4honline.com.
- Camp spaces will *not* be held without payment.
- Returned checks result in \$30 charge.
- If your child is placed on a waitlist, payment will be due if a space opens and you accept.

Additional Information:

- Space is limited, so once enrolled, your child is expected to attend and participate. If your child can no longer attend, please contact the 4-H Office as soon as possible so we can offer the space to the waitlist.
- Please keep track of all camps for which your child has registered. You may receive an email the week before the camp begins, containing additional reminders. Do not rely on this as a reminder.
- Please arrive on time and pick up your children on time.
- If your child will be taking any medication (prescription or over-the-counter) during a 4-H camp, please advise the 4-H staff and supply medication in a labeled container for the leader to be responsible for.
